

10mm. socket, 12mm Wrench, 12mm Socket, Socket Wrench





Using a 10mm. socket remove two (2) factory bolts



1 Get your front cover



Install provided 10mm. bolts and washer in to factory holes and tighten with socket wrench

1 Install three (3) 12mm bolts with washers and nuts

1 Line up rear cover



Install three (3) provided 12mm head bolts washers and nuts



## Step 13/14

Numbered annotations (1)

Tighten all bolts with 12mm wrench and socket.

Repeat for opposite side
